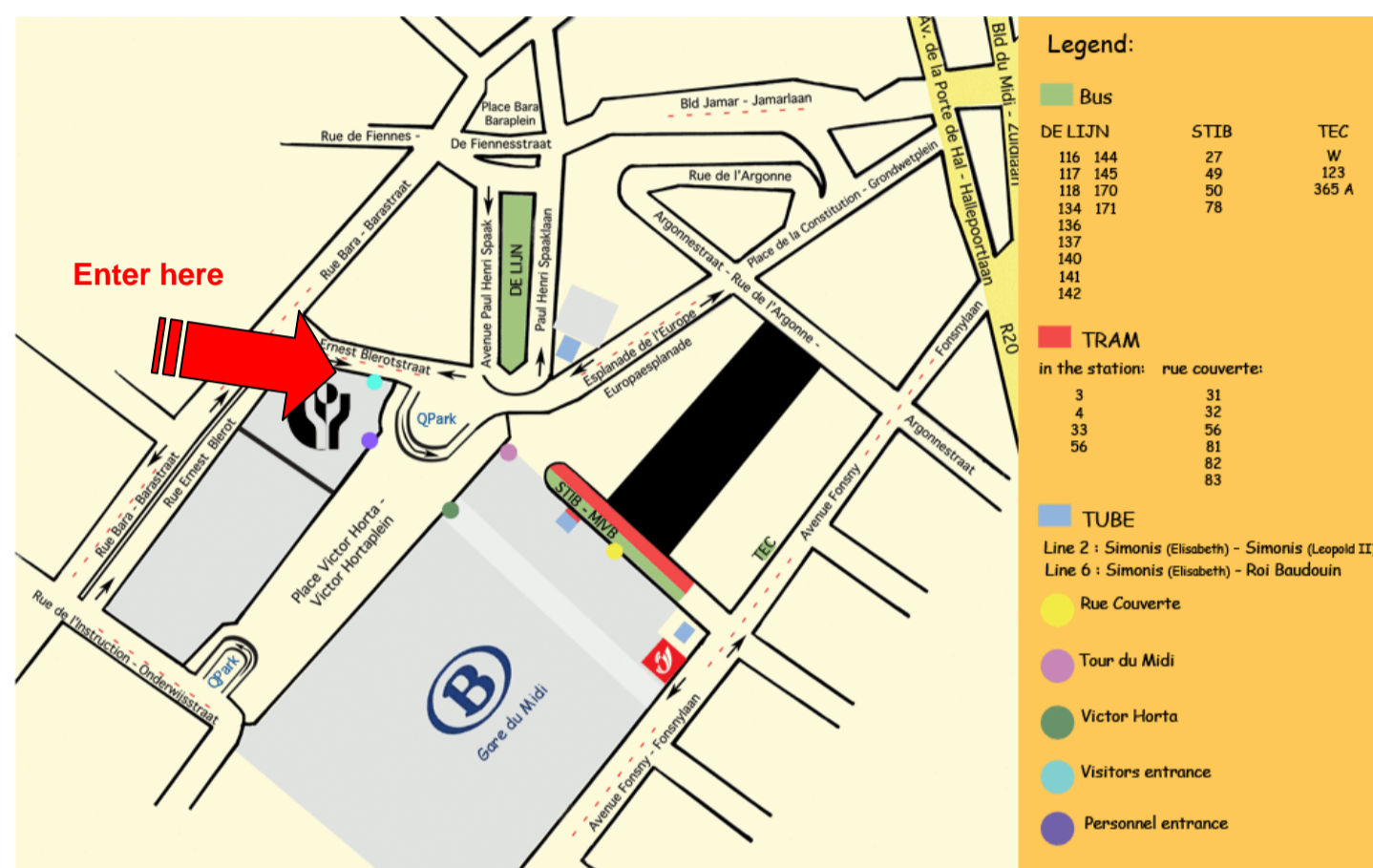

Background

Lipids in the daily diet play an important role in regulating energy metabolism and in health control. As such, they are very important for human health. In this first annual congress of the Belgium Nutrition Society, four main topics related to lipids in nutrition and health will be highlighted, i.e. their role in human metabolism, the presence of undesired lipid soluble compounds in foods and their effect on human health, the role of lipids in food production and technology, and guidelines for dietary lipids intake for specific population groups.

Speakers and posters

For each of the four topics, a keynote speaker has been invited to give a "state of the art" lecture related to his research expertise. Moreover, for each topic, three young Belgian scientists will be selected on the basis of the submitted abstracts to orally present their research work.

Call for presentations and posters.

We also welcome presentations (oral or posters) by researchers. A template for abstracts is provided on our website. Please send your abstract to info@belgiannutritionssociety.be before March 29th. Indicate if you are applying for poster or oral presentation and for which of the four sessions. All abstracts will be peer reviewed. The accepted abstracts will be published in the online version of the Archives of Public Health. (www.iph.fgov.be/aph/).

Note: Although the central theme of the congress is on lipids in nutrition, we welcome topics from all other nutritional areas for oral or poster presentations as well.

Instructions for abstracts

The abstract should be prepared in English using the template provided and should not exceed 250 words. Translations in Dutch and French are strongly encouraged and should be included whenever possible (between the acknowledgement and reference sections). The abstract should state the aim(s) of the study, methods, main findings, and the principal conclusions. A list of 3 to 8 keywords in English must be provided at the bottom of the abstract. Those keywords (in alphabetical order) should be selected from a current copy of the Medical Subject Headings (MeSH) of the English version of the Index Medicus (<http://www.nlm.nih.gov/mesh/2002/MBrowser.html>).
